Take a step back in time to 1942 to hear the stories and see the sites of the Bombing of Darwin.





THE USS PEARY

The USS Peary, which was the most significant US warship to be sunk in the Bombing of Darwin, was preparing to take on fuel when attacked. A total of four bombs crippled the ship, with one bomb exploding the forward magazine. Eighty eight men including the captain were killed or confirmed missing.



ON THIS ECO-CERTIFIED ADVENTURE WE:

- > Travel past historic Charles Point Lighthouse into Bynoe Harbour
- > Arrive at Ngulbitjik (Bare Sand Island) in time for an incredible tropical sunset
- > Enjoy a delicious meal on board
- > Explore the island's interesting history and habitat with Team Turtle.

Under the cover of darkness, with red lights charged, Team Turtle takes you on a guided walk to witness the turtles egg laying ritual. For those who take the adventure late in the season, you may experience the sight of a hatchling taking its first steps – an awesome sight indeed.

More than just a tour, this is a journey with purpose—one that supports conservation, honours cultural heritage, and leaves you with a deeper appreciation of the fragile beauty of the natural world.
