**Your role:** As a Turtle Guide, you will be responsible for co-guiding tour groups of up to 22 people to Bare Sand Island to view and interpret Flatback sea turtles. This role requires a confident individual who has sound knowledge of marine turtle behaviour and biology and is passionate about creating a memorable experience for our guests, whilst keeping safety as a priority.

### Your duties:

- Conduct co-guided turtle tours to Ngulbitjik (Bare Sand Island), which includes tour guiding to groups of up to 22 guests about sea turtle behaviour and biology.
- Be responsible for looking after and educating guests about Ngulbitjik (Bare Sand Island),, and the Flatback sea turtles.
- Provide exceptional customer service to all guests whilst maintaining their safety and comfort. This includes: delivering tour information and activities, serving dinner and drinks on board, and maintaining a safe and clean working environment at all times.
- Tours are conducted on our 12 meter and 13 meter vessels. Any tour related jobs whilst on board and potentially at the office are included in this position. This is a diverse role and you will be expected to make smart and safe decisions in a fast paced environment.
